

RULES OF THE SHOW

CAVY SECTION – WEDNESDAY 19 JUNE 2024

- 1 The Show is to be held under N C C Rules & Regulations.
- 2 No rail stock will be accepted. Pen numbers will be given on arrival at the Show.
- 3 Closing date for entries will be 31 May 2024.
- 4 All exhibits are to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor and to have been vaccinated in accordance with official recommendations.
- 5 The Committee reserve the right to refuse or return entries and appoint another judge should any named judge be unable to officiate for any reason.
- 6 Judging will commence at 10.00 am
EXHIBITORS' VEHICLES WILL NOT BE ADMITTED ON THE SHOWGROUND AFTER 8.30 am.
Lifting time for all exhibits will be 5.00 pm. Stock will be checked in.
- 7 Whilst at the Show, the whole of the exhibits are in the custody of the Show Committee and must not be handled by the exhibitor or any other person.
- 8 Any exhibit considered fraudulently prepared, or a health hazard will be removed from the Show.
- 9 Every care will be taken of the exhibits, but the Society cannot be held responsible for any loss incurred before, during or after the Show.
- 10 Prize monies will be paid out at 4.00 pm on Show Day in the marquee.
- 11 Anyone wishing to lodge a complaint or objection may do so in writing, and by depositing £5.00 with the Rabbit or Cavy Secretary before 12 noon on Show Day. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 12 No stock other than those entered in the Show will be admitted to the marquee.
- 13 Trophies remain the property of the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO and will not be given out. There will be the opportunity for the winning exhibitor to be photographed with the trophy at the Trophy Marquee.
- 14 Any exhibitor, on making entries, is deemed to have read, and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 15 Any exhibitor, on making entries £16.50 or over will receive one free exhibitor ticket over £30 will receive two tickets.
- 16 Car passes will be issued to exhibitors at the discretion of the Society as space for parking is limited. Exhibitors who receive car passes must agree to park in the areas allocated. There is no charge for parking.

You may provide data to us when joining the Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO, booking a trade stand or entering a competition held at The Royal Cheshire County Show. Examples of bodies we may need to share your data with include but are not limited to: caterers who need to be aware of special dietary requirements, breed societies to verify entries, external contractors such as marquee and electricity suppliers and for safety purposes your emergency contact details may be shared with relevant bodies.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO recognises that you have rights surrounding the data we hold. Individuals may contact the Society's Data Protection Officer (DPO) and exercise your rights to be informed about the data we hold, have access to the data we hold, have your data rectified, your right to be forgotten and so forth. Should you make a data request the Society will endeavour to respond within the statutory period.

The Cheshire Agricultural Society CIO will endeavour to keep your data safe and will notify you and the Information Commissioners Officer (ICO) should it become aware of any data breach, within the legal time limit of 72 hours.
